



Start point

START POINT: PAIMPONT ABBEY

(GPS coordinate : 48° 01' 11.064" N / 02° 10' 16.889" 0)

DISTANCE: 12 km

NOTEWORTHY SITES

- 1 Paimpont Abbey (a national Historic Monument): This thirteenth-century Benedictine monastery was occupied by monks until the French Revolution. Neo-Gothic medieval in style, the abbey church boasts baroque interior decor from the seventeenth century. The sacristy hosts the abbey's treasure: a stunning ivory Christ (seventeenth century), a reliquary (fifteenth century) said to hold a radius of Saint Judicaël and a multicoloured wooden statue (fifteenth century). Open to the public.
- The Abbey Lake (listed as a departmental nature area): a stunning 50-hectare body of water adjacent to Paimpont Abbey.
- 🚰 Grotto of Notre-Dame de Paimpont: this site was developed in 1885. The grotto has been a destination for pilarims since the time of the monks.
- A Paimpont Forest (private): extending over 8,000 hectares, this is the largest forest in the Armorica peninsula. It is also a key place in Arthurian legend.
- 🕤 The Cross of Judicaël: a very old purple-schist cross standing in the middle of the forest. This stone cross is very well preserved.

PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT

- Stay on the trails to avoid trampling plants and to minimise erosion,
- Close all gates behind you
- Take your rubbish with you until you find
- Respect the fauna and flora; learn about the importance of conservation
- Ask the local authorities about the hunting season. Some routes may be dangerous during this period
